Limitations for Community Council Member Contracting with the County. See Miami-Dade County Ethics Code at Sec. 2-11.1 (c)(3) and RQO 99-05.

Dear Mr. Imburgia:

The County Ethics Code allows Imburgia Construction Services, Inc., a for-profit firm that you own, to register as a County vendor and contract with the County, as long as the firm does not contract with any County department or agency subject to the regulation, oversight, management, policy-setting or authority of Community Council # 7.

You've stated that you are a member of Community Council #7, Biscayne Shores. Section 2-11.1 (b)(3) of the County Code defines community councils as quasi-judicial boards.

Consequently, as per Section 2-11.1 (c)(3) of the County Code, members of quasi-judicial boards may enter into contracts with the County, either individually or through a firm, as long as the member or firm does not contract with any agency or department of the County subject to the regulation, oversight, management, policy-setting or quasi-judicial authority of the board.
