On 3/7/12, I advised Councilman Andre Williams of the City of Miami Gardens regarding an upcoming vote. Mr. Williams, who is an attorney, advised that he has in the past represented a property owner who was appearing before the Council in connection with clearance of deed restrictions on a building owned by him. A resolution was being sought from the Council to complete negotiations with the county, which previously owned the property, in order to clear the restrictions. I advised Mr. Williams, that, in view of his prior representation of the petitioner, he should refrain from participating in the vote because of the possibility that he could indirectly profit or be enhanced by voting on a matter affecting his client, even though he did not represent the client directly in the matter.
