Hello Craig,

In a conversation today with Lawrence Phillip, a member of Community Council #16, I concurred with your opinion that Professor Phillip does not have a voting conflict related to the University of Miami RSMAS School.

Professor Phillip is no longer employed by the University of Miami; therefore, he does not have a relationship with the entity coming before the Community Council that would prohibit him from voting.

Alternatively, he will not profit or be enhanced by the vote, either directly or indirectly. Although Professor Phillip's wife is employed by the University of Miami, she is not employed by the RSMAS School and the vote will not affect her in any way.

Consequently, as per the County Code at Sec. 20-45, Professor Phillip may vote on the RSMAS School matter that will be presented to Community Council #16.
