Mr. Marquez,

As we discussed, the President of Cisco's Globalization Division and two of his associates are not lobbyists if they meet with Mayor Gimenez to discuss, in general, Cisco's activities abroad.

Although some foreign cities have adopted Cisco's network as a platform for international transactions, we understand that *no issues related to these activities are currently or foreseeably pending in the County.*

As we also discussed, lobbying is defined very broadly by the Ethics Commission to include many actions intended to influence an official decision. We recommend that Cisco representatives govern themselves accordingly.
