Dear Dr. Parodi:

In correspondence to our office on April 24, 2013, you stated that you wish to register your private veterinary service, Alberto G. Parodi, Veterinary Medicine, LLC, as a County vendor.

You stated that you are employed by the Miami-Dade School Board as a substitute teacher.

As an employee of the School Board, you do not fall within the jurisdiction of the Miami-Dade County Code of Ethics. School Board employees are *not* County employees. Consequently, you have no limitations under the County Code for doing business with the County through your private firm, Alberto G. Parodi, Veterinary Medicine, LLC.

Please be advised, however, that as a County vendor, you will become subject to certain provisions of the County Code.
