We note *specifically* that Oracle does *not* reimburse speakers for their travel, hotel, and other expenses related to attending the conference. Consequently, the County Ethics Code at Sec. 2-11.1 (w) is not violated because Mr. Navarrete is not receiving travel-related expenses from Oracle—but merely the customary honorarium for volunteer speakers, *i.e.*, a complimentary pass to enter the event. Additionally, a speaking honorarium is not considered a gift that must be disclosed, as per the County Code at Sec. 2-11.1 (e)(2)(c).

We caution, however, that Mr. Navarrete's travel-related expenses cannot be reimbursed by any other County contractor, vendor, service provider, bidder, or proposer. Attached is a similar ethics opinion given to a County employee who spoke at an event and whose travel-related expenses were appropriately provided by a nonprofit organization. *See* INQ 13-10.

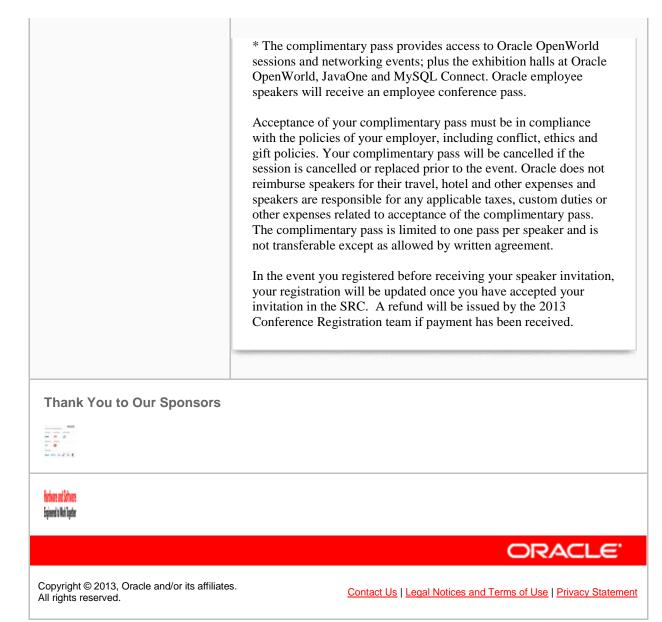
