The basis for this request is that your brother, Fred, is an employee of Turnberry Associates, a company that shares some common ownership with the Fountainebleau Hotel. Your brother is low-level, non-management employee of Turnberry, has no ownership interest in Turnberry, and does not stand to profit or be enhanced in any way by the vote that is the subject of this inquiry. You yourself have no personal interest in this matter whatsoever.

It is my opinion that there is no prohibited conflict of interest under these circumstances and that you may vote on or otherwise participate in the item in question, since you do not have any relationship with the affected party and you do not stand to profit or be enhanced, directly or indirectly by the vote.
