Mayor MacDougall inquired as to whether he would have a prohibited voting conflict regarding a development that will be discussed in an upcoming workshop meeting of the Cutler Bay Council. The developer had approached Mayor MacDougall in his capacity as owner of a real estate company that provides varied services, including title searches. The Mayor's company has not been hired at this point and may not be hired, but he was concerned that the possibility of his being hired would create a problem. I advised him that there is at present a prohibited voting conflict of interest pursuant to Section 2-11.1(d) of the Miami-Dade Code of Ethics since at this point he could still, directly or indirectly, profit or be enhanced by any action of the city regarding this development. Mayor MacDougall was advised to follow the procedures outlined in the recent memo distributed by this office to all elected officials in the county outlining the necessary steps in declaring a conflict.
