Mr. Machado,

Attached is the ethics opinion we discussed today that interprets the County Ethics Code at Sec. 2-11.1 (s)(7) regarding the prohibition on contingency or success fees for lobbyists.

The opinion states that traditional sales commissions are not considered contingency or success fees as proscribed in the County lobbyist ordinance. Therefore, sales commissions customarily earned by sales representatives who register as lobbyists may be agreed to without violating the County Ethics Code.
