Please submit this letter to Neighbors and Neighbors Association, Inc. The Ethics Commission does not submit this letter on your behalf.

You asked if the County Ethics Code would prevent your privately owned company, TriMerge Consulting Group, P.A., from accepting a Mom & Pop Grant funded through Commissioner Jean Monestime's District 2 Office. You serve as the Chair of the Miami-Dade Black Affairs Advisory Board (BAAB).

Briefly, your company may *accept a grant* as long as BAAB is not involved in any way in processing or administering the grant. You *may not lobby for the grant*. (See the County Ethics Code at Secs. 2-11.1 (c) and (m)(1).)

Be advised that the County Ethics Commission has interpreted lobbying very expansively when applied to County employees. This means that you may not contact anyone within the County (or anyone working on behalf of the County, including Hialeah Dade Development) in an attempt to influence his/her decision about the grant you are seeking.

This opinion construes the Miami-Dade Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance only and is not applicable to any conflict under state law. Inquiries regarding possible conflicts under state law should be directed to the State of Florida Commission on Ethics.
