Steve Barrett, Chair of the newly-created Opa-locka Task Force on Municipal Finance, inquired regarding whether the Task Force would be subject to the Florida Sunshine Law, F.S. 286.011. The Task Force is an advisory body created by Opa-locka Mayor Myra Taylor. It is charged with advising the Mayor and City government regarding financial issues in the City, in particular, an existing budget deficit. Barrett was appointed as Chair of the Task Force by the Mayor. The Task Force has no official power, only an advisory function. Mr. Barrett was advised that municipal advisory bodies such as the Task Force are subject to the Florida Sunshine Law, as well as the Miami-Dade County Citizens' Bill of Rights, Section (A)6.
