You have inquired on behalf of Miami-Dade County Commissioner Rebeca Sosa regarding whether she has a prohibited conflict of interest in connection with her voting on or otherwise participating in Item No. 8H1(151150) and Item No. 11A12(151108), both of which involved Resolutions approving agreements between Miami-Dade County and the School Board of Miami-Dade County. This inquiries are made in light of Commissioner Sosa's full time employment with the Miami-Dade Public Schools at the Lindsey-Hopkins Technical Education Center.

INQ 15-134

Item No. 8H1 (151150) involves a resolution approving a cooperative agreement with the School Board of Miami-Dade County to continue the implementation of Project Search and authorizing the County Mayor or his designee to execute the agreement. This program is designed to provide work skills and employment training to young adults with disabilities. It is my understanding that the program will not have any impact personally on Commissioner Sosa or affect her position within Miami-Dade County Public Schools in any way. Because The Miami-Dade Public Schools is a governmental entity rather than a private entity, her employment there would not automatically present a voting conflict pursuant to Section 2-11.1(d) of the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance. Additionally, since Commissioner Sosa does not in any way stand to profit or be enhanced by the vote on this item, she does not have a prohibited conflict of interest and may vote on or participate in the item when it comes before the County Commission.
