Ryce Stallings, an architect employed by Stantec, a responding company to an RFQ at Jackson Health Systems (JHS) inquired concerning the lobbyist registration requirements for individuals appearing for presentations to a selection/evaluation committee on the RFQ in question. I advised him that for those individuals whose only involvement on the RFQ is as part of a presentation team before a selection/evaluation or technical review committee, pursuant to Section 2-11.1(s)(5) of the County Ethics Code, there is no requirement to register as a lobbyist, provided that such individuals are listed on the County affidavit filed with the Clerk's Office. As to any other individuals who are involved in lobbying activity in other meetings, they would have to register with the County.
