PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Jim Garrett (Garrett) filed this complaint against Mary Estime-Irvin (Estime-Irvin), City of North Miami Commissioner, alleging that Estime-Irvin violated Section 6-47(a) of the City of North Miami Code and Section 106.07 (1), Florida Statutes, by failing to or untimely filing campaign finance reports.

A legally sufficient complaint exists where there are allegations of a violation of an ordinance within the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission, purportedly committed by an individual within the authority of the Ethics Commission.

The allegation set forth in this complaint is beyond the jurisdiction of the Commission on Ethics and Public Trust.

On March 11, 2020, in closed session, the Ethics Commission's General Counsel recommended that the case be dismissed. In open session, the Ethics Commission voted unanimously to find No Legal Sufficiency and dismissed the case.


Wherefore it is:
