PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Complainant Cristy Fernandez (Fernandez) filed this complaint against Ms. Quatisha Oguntoyinbo-Rashad (Rashad), the Chief of Environmental Resources, and David DeLoach (DeLoach), Environmental Resource Officer I at the City of Miami.

Complainant has an issue with a building permit she submitted to the City of Miami. Among other things, Complainant's issues with the City involve a pre-existing violation on the property, a violation that apparently was closed out but was re-opened by the City, as well as a fine related to tree removal. Complainant questions Respondent's professionalism and competence.

Legal sufficiency exists where there is an allegation of a violation of an ordinance within the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission, purportedly committed by an individual within the authority of the Ethics Commission and filed with the Ethics Commission within three years of the alleged violation.

On February 12, 2020, the Ethics Commission agreed with the recommendation of the Advocate that the Complainant's issues are not within the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission. Any issues concerning the competence and professionalism of the Respondents as City employees is a personnel matter which is outside the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission pursuant to Section 2-1067 of the Code of Miami-Dade County.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C20-04-01(A, B) against Respondents Rashad and DeLoach is hereby dismissed.
