PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Complainant, Gladys Mezrahi, filed this complaint against Rachel Friedland, in her capacity as candidate for Aventura Commissioner. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated the Ethical Campaign Practices Ordinance at Section 2-11.1.1 (C)(1)(c) by willfully damaging or defacing campaign material.

On November 16, 2020, Complainant, by and through her counsel, requested to withdraw the complaint made against Respondent pursuant to Rule 4.3, COE Rules of Procedure.

On December 9, 2020, the Ethics Commission granted Ms. Mezrahi's request to withdraw the complaint.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C20-36-09 against Respondent Rachel Friedland is hereby dismissed.
