PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

The Miami Beach Office of Inspector General (MBOIG) provided information to the COE alleging that Respondent, Justin Karr (Karr), an attorney working for the City of Miami Beach as a real estate asset specialist, was engaged in unauthorized outside employment relating to Karr's apparent representation of private legal clients. Records provided by the MBOIG further suggested Karr may have used his city computer and e-mail account while providing legal representation to private individuals and businesses.

On February 10, 2021 Respondent entered a Stipulation to Probable Cause and Settlement Agreement agreeing to plead No Contest to COUNT TWO of the complaint Section 2-11.1(K)(2) for failing to report his outside employment. Respondent agreed to pay a fine of \$500.00 and accept a Letter of Instruction. Pursuant to the negotiated settlement, COUNT ONE of the complaint, Exploitation of official position prohibited is dismissed.

On February 10, 2021 the Ethics Commission accepted the Stipulation to Probable Cause and Settlement Agreement.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C21-01-01 is concluded.
