PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

The Advocate filed a complaint against Respondent, attorney Bruce Jacobs, (Jacobs) for lobbying without being properly registered City of Miami Commissioner Ken Russell (Russell). The lobbying concerned a Resolution that proposed the creation of a funding mechanism for affordable housing.

On February 10, 2021 the Ethics Commission accepted the Stipulation to Probable Cause and Settlement Agreement entered into by Respondent which called for his plea of No Contest to violating Section 2-11.1(s)(2) of the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics ordinance. Pursuant to Section 2-1074(s)(ii) of the Code of Miami-Dade County and pursuant to the Settlement Agreement it appeared the violation was inadvertent, unintentional, or insubstantial wherefore, the Respondent will accept a Letter of Instruction and the complaint is dismissed.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C21-02-01 is dismissed and Respondent will be issued a Letter of Instruction.
