PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Complainant, Jacqueline Quintanilla (Quintanilla), filed this complaint against Jose Nadine Garcon, the psychologist assigned to the court-ordered evaluation of the Complainant regarding a child custody case between Quintanilla and the father of the child.

Legal sufficiency exists where the complaint adequately alleges a violation of an ordinance within the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission, committed by an individual within the authority of the Ethics Commission, based substantially on the personal knowledge of the Complainant and filed with the Ethics Commission within three years of the alleged violation.

This complaint addresses an issue between private parties involved in a legal child custody dispute that has no nexus to County or municipal government under the County Ethics Code.

On April 14, 2021, the Ethics Commission dismissed the complaint for lack of legal sufficiency.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C21-06-03 against Respondent Garcon is hereby dismissed.
