PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Complainant, Iliana D. Pena (Pena), filed this complaint against Juan Segarra (Segarra), a private General Contractor, alleging refusal to perform on a private contract involving construction in her residence.

Legal sufficiency exists where the complaint adequately alleges a violation of an ordinance within the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission, committed by an individual within the authority of the Ethics Commission, based substantially on the personal knowledge of the Complainant and filed with the Ethics Commission within three years of the alleged violation.

This complaint addresses an issue between private parties involved in a contractual dispute that has no nexus to County or municipal government under the County Ethics Code.


On March 9, 2022, the Ethics Commission dismissed the complaint for lack of legal sufficiency.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C22-06-02 against Respondent Segarra is hereby dismissed.
