Dear Mr. Serralta:

You requested an opinion regarding your ability to serve as a member of the Public Health Trust. I am rendering this opinion based on the facts contained in your request.

In your letter, you advised me that you recently applied for a position with the Public Health Trust. You are currently serving as territory representative for Pfizer Pharmaceutical. You have worked for Pfizer for seven years and primarily market Zyvox and Vfend for Pfizer. You are not an officer of the corporation.

The Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics ordinance permits you to serve as a member of the Public Health Trust. However, if you are selected, you are prohibited from disclosing any confidential information acquired as a member of the Trust or using your membership on the Trust to benefit Pfizer or any other entity. Further, you are prohibited from voting on any matter that impacts Pfizer, directly or indirectly, during any term on the Trust.

Accordingly, you may serve on the Trust subject to the restrictions contained herein that apply to all Trust members.

This opinion construes the Miami-Dade Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics ordinance only and is not applicable to any conflict under state law. Please contact the State of Florida Commission on Ethics if you have any questions regarding possible conflicts under state law.
