Jenny,

A County employee cannot enter into a contract with his or her County department. Having said that, if the costs of the party is being shared by employees and management (out of their own pockets) and no County funds are being expended, then this amounts to a private agreement between two parties, with one of the two parties being Memories By Estrella. If the other party, who works for ETSD but signs the contract with Memories By Estrella in his/her private capacity, a conflict of interest will not exist under the county's Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance.

Of course, the employee providing the catering services has to charge fair market value for the ETSD party and she would be required to disclose the income she generated from this party when she files her disclosure form in July 2007.
