Miami-Dade CAA and Miami-Dade OCED are requesting an opinion from the Ethics Commission on the following language in relation to the Miami-Dade County Citizen Participation Plan and Guidelines for Office of Community and Economic Development and Community Action Agencies Community Advisory Committees. This is a document that governs the community advisory committees operating under CAA and OCED.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST

Any member who holds a board position with any agency receiving funds from CAA or OCED shall be able to retain or run for a position on a Community Advisory

Committee as long as the following conditions are adhered to:

- A member must recuse his/herself and physically leave the room while any discussion arises that involves funding decisions related to that agency or any discussion about that agency in general.
- The records of the meeting must reflect the above-required actions of the member.

Any member in violation of conflict of interest will automatically be removed from the Committee by the CAC Chairperson.

An Advisory Committee member whose immediate family receives a financial benefit or serves as a Board member of an organization that may benefit as a result of action before that Advisory Committee will make known that interest and must refrain from voting.
