In order for me to give you an opinion, I will state the relevant facts: 1) You recently started working for the County; 2) You worked as a Professional Land Surveyor prior to your employment with the County and 3) Your former client has an item that is currently before the County. Based on a previous opinion the Commission on Ethics issued, I conclude that any documents that are submitted on behalf of the applicant which contain your signature as a Professional Surveyor would not be in violation of the County Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance.

Please understand that you are prohibited from appearing in front of any County committee or board and may not meet with County staff to discuss the abovementioned application. The rationale behind granting you the waiver is that your role in this matter was strictly limited to preparing the survey for the client. If you were to assume a greater role than simply preparing the survey, it could conceivably be a violation of the Code of Ethics Ordinance.
