Allegation(s):

Received information via e-mail that the City of North Miami (NM), through its City Council was planning to turn over the Griffin Center (city property) to a private company, in order to provide services to elder citizens. The e-mail further stated that the City would pay all the expenses and the item was placed on the consent agenda which meant it was not advertised to the public.

Relevant Ordinances:

Exploitation of official position, Sec. 2-11.1(g), Miami-Dade Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance.

"No person included in the terms defined in Subsections (b)(1) through (6) and (b)(13) shall use or attempt to use his or her official position to secure special privileges or exemptions for himself or herself or others..."

Investigation:

Interviews

Documents obtained from NM revealed the agreement was only for the use of the Griffin Elderly Center (Center) by the NM Elderly Center (non-profit) to provide services to the elderly community of NM. A contract was executed by NM with Haitian Elderly Center, Inc. a Florida non-profit corporation d/b/a North Miami Elderly Center.

In the agreement, NM grants the non-profit a rent free license, for the use of the center. In return, the non-profit agrees to maintain the facility, have use of it Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and NM has the right to inspect as required.


The non-profit also has to have insurance and operate the facility on its own expense.

Conclusion(s):

Advocate Michael Murawski advised that no further action would be taken since there does not appear to be any Ethics related violations. Accordingly, it is recommended that the above case be closed.
