
SETTLEMENT ORDER


Pursuant to section 5.13 of the Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust Rules of Procedure, Petitioner and Respondent do hereby enter into this settlement in full satisfaction of the above captioned matter based upon the following terms and conditions:

1. Respondent, JUDY WALDMAN does hereby agree not to contest the allegation in Count I of Ethics Complaint C05-30 and to pay to the Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) and accept a Letter of Instruction in full satisfaction of Ethics Complaint number C05-30.
2. The Advocate recommends that as part of this negotiated settlement, Count II be dismissed.
3. Failure by respondent to pay all monies due, as outlined in paragraph 1 above, may result in garnishment or other appropriate processes or proceedings to enforce the recovery of a judgement as governed by the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure.
4. Failure by respondent to fulfill and abide by his obligation under this Agreed Settlement Order may also result in contempt proceedings against respondent.
5. Respondent agrees to the terms of this settlement agreement knowingly, freely and without duress.
6. Petitioner and Respondent agree that settlement of this action in the manner described above is just and in the best interests of Respondent and the citizens of Miami-Dade County.
