Pursuant to section 5.13 of the Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust Rules of Procedure, Petitioner and Respondent do hereby enter into this settlement in full satisfaction of the above captioned matter based upon the following terms and conditions:

1. Respondent, BARRY R. DAVIDSON, does hereby acknowledge that at all times material to the complaint at bar, he was not registered for 2005 pursuant to section 2-11.1(s)(1)(a)-(b) and (2)(a)-(c) of the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance.
2. Respondent agrees to register for 2005 and pay the \$490 registration fee.
3. Respondent agrees to comply with all sections of the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance in the future, specifically section 2-11.1.
4. Respondent further agrees to pay the Commission on Ethics and Public Trust \$250 in investigative fees.
5. In exchange, the Commission agrees to dismiss complaint C06-01.
6. Respondent agrees to the terms of this settlement agreement knowingly, freely and without duress.
7. Petitioner and Respondent agree that settlement of this action in the manner described above is just and in the best interests of Respondent and the citizens of Miami-Dade County.
