

SETTLEMENT ORDER

Pursuant to section 5.13 of the Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust Rules of Procedure, Petitioner and Respondent do hereby enter into this settlement in full satisfaction of the above captioned matter based upon the following terms and conditions:

1. Respondent admits the allegation in Count I and agrees not to contest the allegations in Counts II and III of Amended Ethics complaint C06-05.
2. Respondent agrees to pay a fine of \$1, 250.00 and investigative costs of \$500.00 for a total of \$1,750.00 and to accept a written admonishment and Letter of Instruction from the Ethics Commission in full satisfaction of amended ethics complaint C06-05; said payment to be made contemporaneously with the settlement of this matter.
3. By signing this agreement, Respondent represents that he fully understands the allegations contained in amended ethics complaint C06-05, has had an opportunity to discuss the allegations contained in the complaint with his attorney, and is entering into this settlement agreement freely and voluntarily.
4. Respondent further acknowledges that this settlement agreement in no way precludes administrative action being taken against Respondent by his employer, the City of Miami.
5. Petitioner and Respondent agree that settlement of this action in the manner described above is just and in the best interests of Respondent and the citizens of Miami-Dade County.
