PUBLIC REPORT AND ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

John Wade filed the above-captioned complaint against Commissioner Natasha Seijas ("Respondent") for violation of Section 2-11.1(d) (voting conflicts) for voting on the date of her recall election.

The Respondent was involved in a recall election last fall. In October, 2006, the Board of County Commissioners voted on the date of the recall election. The Respondent moved the item, participated in discussion regarding the circumstances of the recall and voted on the matter.

On January 30, 2007, the Ethics Commission found the complaint legally sufficient. Thereafter, after reviewing the Advocate's no probable cause recommendation, the oral and written argument of Respondent's counsel and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Ethics Commission dismissed the complaint for lack of probable cause.

Therefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT the Complaint is
DISMISSED for lack of probable cause.
