PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Complainant, Stephanie Kienzle (Kienzle) filed this complaint against the Mayor of North Miami, Phillipe Bien-Aimee (Bien-Aimee).

All of the activity Kienzle complains about in her complaint allegedly occurred in October and November of 2014. Pursuant to Section 2-1074 (x) of the Code of Miami-Dade County (the Ethics Commission's enabling ordinance) "no action may be taken on a complaint filed more than three (3) years after the violation is alleged to have accrued..."

Since all of the activity complained of in the complaint happened more than four (4) years ago, any prosecution of the ethics code is barred by the three (3) year statute of limitations.

On June 12, 2019 the Ethics Commission found that this complaint was not legally sufficient and dismissed it.

Wherefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C19-27-05 is dismissed.
