The Miami-Dade Commission on Ethics and Public Trust has instituted a virtual platform to offer online Lobbyist Training and Lobbyist Refresher Course training in response to the global pandemic we are currently facing. Although we have gone live with Phase 1 and 2 of this virtual training which allows an individual to view the course and print their certificate of completion, we are still working on completing Phase 3 of the project that will augment the websites' capabilities. Because we are currently in the midst of this rollout, we have learned that the existing sign-up process has brought about some confusion. In order to clear up some of this confusion please be aware of the following when signing-up for virtual training:

- 1) You must click <u>here</u> in order to sign-up for your course.
- 2) Although the website lists actual dates that you must select to take the course on, please be aware that the training session is completely online and the course can be viewed at any time or day that you deem suitable. There is no in person training.
- 3) Once you sign-up and pay for the course, you **will be sent an email** within 24-48 hours that will contain a link to another website where you can view the course and generate your certificate of completion.
- 4) If you think you have not reached an email with the link to view the online course please check your spam/junk emails before contacting the Commission on Ethics.
- 5) Be aware that if you do not pay for the course then your Certificate of Completion will not be valid.
