Dear Chris,

You inquired concerning whether sitting County judges serving on County advisory Boards must complete County ethics training required of County advisory board members. The requirement for ethics training of County advisory board members is in R-189-05 (attached). It requires that all County board members receive ethics training from the Commission on Ethics and Public Trust. There is no exemption for members of the judiciary who serve on County advisory boards. County advisory board training is conducted monthly at our Commission office at 19 W. Flagler Street, Suite 820. The schedule for the training may be found on our website at [ethics.miamidade.gov](http://ethics.miamidade.gov). It is conducted by Commission staff is open all County advisory board members.

I would add that the financial disclosure requirement for advisory board members, pursuant to Section 2-11.1(i)(1), may be satisfied by compliance with the financial disclosure provisions of Chapter 112. Therefore, judges filing annual financial disclosure forms with the State will satisfy this requirement and need not file a County Source of Income form.
