Re: INQ 18-63, Limitations on Doing Business with the County

Dear Ms. Guerrero:

You have inquired about limitations on doing business with the County. In your application dated March 2, 2018, you advised the Ethics Commission that while you are not a County employee, your son, Juan David Rey, is a County employee who works for the Miami-Dade Dade Parks Recreation and Open Spaces department (MDPR) as a Grant Specialist.

The County Ethics Code at Sections 2-11.1(c)(2), (d), and (g) allow you to enter into a contract, individually or through a firm, with Miami-Dade County, as long as the contract does not interfere with the full and faithful discharge of your son's duties to the County. This means that your son, Juan David Rey, shall not participate in determining the contract requirements or in awarding the contract. Additionally, none of Mr. Rey's job responsibilities and job descriptions shall require him to be involved in the contract in any way including, but not limited to, its enforcement, oversight, administration, amendment, extension, termination or forbearance. In your case, this means that Luna Interior Solutions Inc. shall not enter into contracts MDPR.

Furthermore, your son may not use his County position to secure **special privileges or exemptions** with respect to the contract and he may not lobby the County on behalf of your business. *See* County Ethics Code §§ 2-11.1(g) and (m).

This opinion is limited to the facts as you presented them to the Commission on Ethics regarding conflicts under Subsections (c), (d), (g), and (m) of the Miami-Dade Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance only. Other conflicts, based on directives from your son's Department or under state law, may apply. If you have additional questions regarding possible conflicts based on Department directives, contact your son's Department supervisor or the Mayor's Office. Questions regarding the state ethics laws should be addressed to the State of Florida Commission on Ethics.
