Mr. Wylde,

The Miami Dade Commission on Ethics and Public Trust is responsible for interpreting and enforcing the Lobbying Registration and Reporting Ordinance. Any person who meets with County staff in an effort to persuade or influence them to purchase the products or services of the sales representative's company is considered a lobbyist and must register. A person merely sharing information with County staff is probably not lobbying.

When you indicate in your e-mail that employees in your company talk to different groups within Miami-Dade County, this could be a form of lobbying depending on who is present at the these meetings and the matters discussed. The bottom line is the Ethics Commission has issued several opinions finding that sales representing make presentations and proposals to County to purchase their products are lobbying. Failure to register may result in that person and his/her firm from being permitted to do business with Miami-Dade County government for a period of time.
