I reviewed the advisory opinion issued by the State of Florida Commission on Ethics and our office has no authority to interpret state law, so I can't agree or disagree with it. However, I can offer an opinion under the County's Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance and I find that members of a permanent local board are bound by the county ethics ordinance, which includes the financial disclosure requirements. If the Special Trial Board falls within this category, then its members must file financial disclosure forms. If, on the other hand, this board is akin to an ad hoc committee, then the ethics ordinance would not apply. I will leave it up to your city attorney to decide in which category this particular board falls.
