First, the Ethics Commission can only give advisory opinions to the individuals directly involved in the matter. In the question you asked, we would need to receive a request in writing (emails are OK) directly from either the affected employee and/or the supervisory. Also, we would need to have the complete facts of the case before us, especially, the employee's duties with the county, whether the vendor does business with the employee's department, and similar specifics.

Finally, regardless of the opinion of the Ethics Commission, permission to engage in outside employment ultimately resides with the employee's supervisor.
