Mr. Rodriguez:

Michael Murawski forwarded me your e-mail and I will respond to your questions. Once you retire from the County, you are barred from lobbying Miami-Dade County officials or employees for a period of two years. If you do consulting work for firms transacting business with Miami-Dade County, your interactions with the County must be limited. There is nothing in the Two Year Rule that prohibits you from working as a subcontractor or subconsultant on a Miami-Dade County contract; however, if you wished to serve as a prime contractor with Miami-Dade County or if your subcontracting work required you to interface with County officials or employees, you might be in violation of the Two Year Rule. The Two Year Rule does not apply to any work you might perform on a municipal contract within Miami-Dade County. Furthermore, the Two Year Rule does not prevent you from handling routine administrative matters for clients who have business with the County, but any matter that would not be defined as routine could potentially result in a violation of the Two Year Rule.
