Nicole,

As we discussed, the County Code at Sec. 2-11.1 (s)(1)(b) specifically includes “principal” in the definition of “lobbyist.” The City Attorney of the City of Miami agrees with this definition. *See* City Attorney Opinion ID No. 10-2745.

The City of Miami applies its definition of “principal” to those associated with both for-profit and nonprofit entities.

Although principals are required to register as lobbyists, in June 2010, the County amended its lobbying ordinance to exempt all principals from paying lobbyist registration fees. *See* County Code at Sec. 2-11.1 (s)(3)(b).

This exemption is limited to the payment of the lobbyist fees only. *Principals are still required to register as lobbyists and to file Annual Expenditure Reports.*
