Mr. Foeman,

The Coral Gables Art Advisory Panel is considered to be an “advisory board” whose members are required to file financial disclosure statements with your office.

Prior to 2008, certain advisory boards were allowed to “opt out” of filing financial disclosure statements, but that alternative was eliminated by Resolution 08-53, which is attached.

Consequently, members of the Coral Gables Art Advisory Panel must submit either a Source of Income Statement, a State Form 1, or a 2011 Federal Income Tax Return to your office by July 1 in satisfaction the requirement under the County Code at Sec. 2-11.1 (i).
