Hello Diana,

In response to your question as to whether Commissioner Moss may appoint a County employee from his office staff to serve as a member of the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Citizens Advisory Committee, I have conferred with our Executive Director and we see nothing in the Ethics Code that prohibits this type of appointment.

Please be advised, however, that the County employee will be serving in his/her capacity as a *citizen-appointee* and, as with all other advisory board members, the *citizen-appointee* is not compensated for his/her board service. This means that the *citizen-appointee* would be attending committee meetings "off the clock," not on County time or in his/her capacity as a County employee.
