Your company has no limitations under Sec. 2-11.1 (c)(2) of the County Ethics Code to do business with the County.

Dear Mr. Yanes:

We have reviewed your request for an ethics opinion and find that your privately owned company, Miami Fireball Academy, LLC, has no limitations under the County Ethics Code at Sec. 2-11.1 (c)(2) to do business with the County.

Neither you nor any of your immediate family members are employed by Miami-Dade County. Your mother, Lissett Serpa, is employed by the Miami-Dade County School Board, which is not a County agency.

As an employee of the School Board, your mother does not fall within the jurisdiction of the Miami-Dade County Code of Ethics. However, as a County vendor, be advised that you will be subject to certain sections of the County Code as well as relevant state law.
