Because the Miami-Dade County Ethics Code at Sec. 2-11.1 does not address dual office holding, we are unable to respond to your question about serving as both a member of the Miami-Dade County Fire Prevention and Safety Appeals Board and also as a Miami-Dade County Hearing Officer.

The general prohibition regarding dual office holding is found at Article II, section 5(a), of the Florida Constitution and is interpreted by the Florida Attorney General. A discussion of what constitutes dual office holding can be found at the Attorney General's website at
