Cedric Johnson, who recently retired from the Miami-Dade County Office of Inspector General, inquired regarding post-employment restrictions. He said that he is forming his own LLC to do contract investigative work. He said that he may be working for companies that do business with the county. I advised them that he is permitted to work for a county contractor, but would be restricted from doing any lobbying at the county for a period of two years from his separation from the county, pursuant to Section 2-11.1(q) of the County Code of Ethics. I advised him that, as long as he was not meeting with county officials or personnel to affect decision-making at the county, he should be able to perform investigative work on behalf of county contractors.
