Ms. Gulley,

You have inquired on behalf of Ms. Patricia Braynon, Director of the Miami-Dade Housing Finance Authority (HFA) regarding her acceptance of a retirement party being sponsored by a number of private developers and firms that have done business with the HFA. The event in question is to take place on Thursday, August 28, 2014 at the Wynwood Kitchen & Bar, 2550 N.W. 2nd Avenue, Miami, FL. The party includes hors d'oeuvres, drinks and a steel drum band. The sponsors include the following: Atlantic Pacific Communities, Bryant Miller Olive, Cornerstone Group, eHousing Plus, Foley & Lardner LLP, Gatehouse Companies, Housing Trust Group, Landmark Companies, Inc., Law Offices of Richard Kuper, P.A., Manuel Alonso-Poch P.A., New Urban Development, Public Resources Advisory Group, RBC Capital Markets LLC, Related Urban, Stearns Weaver Miller Weissler, et.al.

There are several reasons why this particular event, sponsored by firms that either do business with HFA or do business with HFA via obtaining bond financing, is inappropriate.

The list of sponsors includes firms that have contracted with HFA. A brief check with the Clerk's office has indicated that a number of these firms have employed lobbyists in connection with their county work. Ms. Braynon, as a Department Director, would likely be considered a "Reporting Individual or Procurement Employee" pursuant to Section 112.3148, Florida Statutes. The latter statute prohibits such individuals from "knowingly accepting, directly or indirectly, a gift from a vendor doing business with the reporting individual's or procurement employee's agency...or a lobbyist who lobbies the reporting individual's or procurement employee's agency, or directly or indirectly on behalf of the partner, firm, employer, or principal of a lobbyist, if he or she knows or reasonably believes that the gift has a value in excess of \$100..." It is my understanding that the amount to be contributed by each sponsor of this event exceeds \$100.

From the circumstances above, it appears that the acceptance by Ms. Braynon of the sponsored party by the above-named firms, which include firms doing business with the HFA as well as employing lobbyists in connection with said business, could violate Section 112.3148, Florida Statutes.

In addition, the Miami-Dade County Ethics Code, Section 2-11.1(e)(3) would prohibit Ms. Braynon from accepting "from another person or entity any gift for or because of: (a) An official public action taken or to be taken, which could be taken; (b) A legal duty performed or to be performed, or which could be performed; or (c) A legal duty violated or to be violated, or which could be violated..." Those involved in the sponsorship of the event may be sincerely motivated by a desire to express appreciation to a worthy public servant for her years of service to Miami-Dade County. However, the direct expenditure of funds by these firms in connection with such an event could be construed as being made because of her actions as a public servant, where the firms in question have done business with the HFA over the years. Without

suggesting any impropriety by her or any of those on the list of sponsors, in an abundance of caution such a benefit from private developers doing business with one's agency should not be accepted.

While the Code does not specifically prohibit "appearances of impropriety," the sponsorship of such an event by county contractors and lobbyists, which would likely be attended by many county employees, including employees of the HFA, would create an appearance issue that would not reflect favorably on the county or the HFA. It has been the policy of the Commission on Ethics to discourage actions which could contribute to a lessening of the public trust in the integrity of county government.

Ms. Braynon is to be commended for her years of honorable and faithful service to the county. I am sure that there are other ways in which her friends and colleagues could express their appreciation for her service.
