Mr. Nares:

The prohibitions of Section 2-11.1(w) apply to any county contractor. If an entity receives funds from the County, and, pursuant the grant of County funds enters into an agreement with the County regarding how those funds will be spent, then it is a county contractor. On the other hand, there is an exception for travel expenses paid by other governmental entities or by organizations of which the County is a member if the travel is related to that membership. So even if The Beacon Council and Greater Miami Convention and Visitors Bureau are County contractors, they could still contribute if the County is a member of those organizations and the travel is related to that membership. I do not have the facts to answer these questions, but I assume that the information is readily available to you.

You have inquired in your capacity as Chief, Economic Development and International Trade Unit of the Miami-Dade County Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, regarding the ethical propriety of accepting a \$15,000 sponsorship from Odebrecht USA, a Miami-Dade County contractor, to fund a Business Development Mission to Brazil during November. You have explained that a county-created and staffed 501(c)(3) organization, Trade Mission Center of the Americas, is the entity that is actually collecting the sponsorship and registration fees that will be used to fund the mission. That organization is overseen by a County board, the International Trade Consortium (ITC), which is chaired by Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz (District 12).

Odebrecht, in response to a flyer generated by your agency, has contributed \$15,000 as an exclusive Platinum Sponsor of the trip. At this point the \$15,000 is 2/3 of the monies that have been contributed. You are continuing to seek other sponsorships and anticipate that there will be a number of private individuals or entities that will pay the \$1100 registration fee to attend the event, but who will be responsible for their own travel and lodging expenses. It is anticipated that the delegation will be led by Mayor Carlos Gimenez and will include Commissioner Diaz, yourself, and one other employee of your agency (all of whom will have their travel, lodging and incidental expenses paid out of the sponsorship and registration fees), and an as yet undetermined number of paid registrants.

Section 2-11.1(w) of the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance provides that no county official or employee "shall accept, directly or indirectly, any travel expenses, including, but not limited to, transportation, lodging, meals, registration fees and incidentals, from any County contractor, vendor, service provider, bidder or proposer." This provision may be waived by a majority vote of the County Commission.

Inasmuch as Section 2-11.1(w) would prohibit Odebrecht from directly or indirectly paying for the travel, lodging and incidentals of County officials and employees on this trip, it is my opinion that the public officials and employees involved could not go on this trip and thereby accept these paid expenses, without a waiver granted by the Board of County Commissioners. Acceptance of sponsorships from persons or entities that are not County contractors, vendors or services providers would not be prohibited under the aforesaid section.

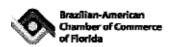
