Pursuant to Section 2.11.1(r) of the Miami-Dade County Code, in a letter dated February 18, 2003 (the "Letter"), Earth Tech requested an advisory opinion from the Commission on Ethics and Public Trust ("Ethics Commission") as to whether or not Earth Tech could pursue teaming opportunities and participate in the procurement process for the MIC/MIA Connector, without violating the Conflict of Interest Code of Miami-Dade County. In the Letter, Earth Tech advised the Ethics Commission that it is currently under contract with the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") to provide professional and technical support exclusively for the Miami Intermodal Center ("MIC").

On March 3, 2003, the Ethics Commission issued Advisory Opinion No. 03-33 in response to said Letter (the "Advisory Opinion"). Therein, the Ethics Commission opined that "Earth Tech may work on the Automated People Mover system if the firm relinquishes any management coordination responsibilities with the Aviation Department relating to overlapping areas in the MIC project. Earth Tech may not continue those responsibilities because the firm would serve as manager and contractor on the same project."

The purpose of this correspondence is to formally notify the Ethics Commission that Earth Tech may actively participate in the procurement process for the MIA Mover. If we participate and are selected, Earth Tech will relinquish any management coordination responsibilities with the Aviation Department relating to overlapping areas in the MIC project, consistent with the findings of the Ethics Commission as expressed in the Advisory Opinion.
