Mr. Meyers, please allow the following correspondence to refresh your memory on my case.

I am in receipt of your email of June 14, 2004, concerning outside employment and am very concerned about the implications about such a broad policy.

I understand the issue of "lobbying" other County Agencies, and will obviously comply with the directive. What is particularly concerning is the part where filing documents and seeking permits from other County Agencies are also prohibited.

As a professional engineer, I sign and seal plans that will be permitted or approved by different County Agencies. I will not personally "file" those plans, but my partner; who is not a County employee will. I may also have to answer questions pertaining the design of the plans I have signed if called to do so.

Based on the opinion I received earlier, I have entered into a partnership, formed a Corporation, incurred in significant expenses, and more alarming; have entered into business agreements and contracts with several individuals and companies and are in the process of fulfilling my commitments under those legal agreements. To forfeit or breach those contracts at this point will be disastrous to me and my partner, and we will be legally liable.

I sincerely hope that my interpretation of this new policy is mistaken and my fears unfounded; but will like your comments on the above as soon as possible.
